



HHI-Nachwuchspreis

donated by the Society of Friends of the Heinrich-Hertz-Institute e.V.

The award serves to honour and promote scientists who are or have been working in a field of research at the Fraunhofer Heinrich-Hertz-Institute. The prize is awarded for outstanding master's / diploma theses and / or dissertations that are of particular significance for the research and development work of the HHI. The award is associated with a monetary prize of **1,000 Euros**.

Criteria for awarding the prize:

- The work should have resulted from the scientific research and development tasks of the Heinrich-Hertz-Institute.
- There must be a professional assessment by the supervisor or an expert reviewer. Only outstanding work with an above-average evaluation will be considered. Moreover, the extent to which the work contributes an innovative solution to an urgent problem is important.

Further criteria comprising the importance of the work results for

- ongoing research and development tasks,
- the acquisition of research and development contracts, and
- patents, patent applications or potential for patents.

The application documents must specifically state whether and in what way the above criteria are met by the respective work.

Based on these criteria, the Board of the Society of Friends of the HHI in consultation with the management of the Fraunhofer HHI will nominate the award winners.

We ask the applicants to submit

- a copy of the thesis,
- the summary of the work with a list of relevant publications,
- the professional assessment, as well as
- meaningful information on the above-mentioned criteria
